Girls

- Summer red/white checked dress (optional)

Boys

- Red sweatshirt (bearing the school emblem)
- White shirt or polo shirt
- Grey tailored trousers or shorts
- Grey or black socks
- <u>Plain</u> black shoes suitable for both indoor and outdoor use (can be <u>plain</u> <u>black</u> trainers)

PE Kit

- White t-shirt (plain or with logo)
- Red shorts
- Plain black tracksuit bottoms
- <u>Plain</u> black or red sweatshirt/ top (optional for warmth)
- Trainers (supportive for running around)
 should be in school every day
- Socks (as above)

Foundation Stage (Nursery and Reception)

As above, except plain black tracksuit bottoms or shorts should be worn throughout the day.
