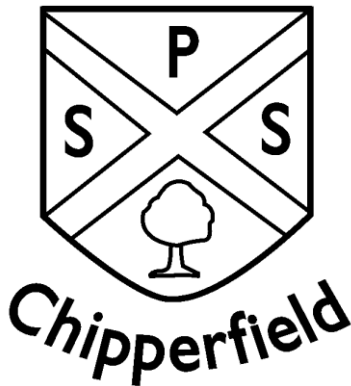

## **SCHOOL PRACTICE**

As part of our practice in keeping parents informed and involved in school, we aim to:

### ***Provide written documentation such as:***

- A website which is updated regularly.
- Curriculum information leaflets.
- Yearly annual progress and attainment reports.
- Published policies made available in the school office, and some on our website.
- Starting school documentation.
- Regular newsletters.

### ***Provide opportunities to meet with and share with parents such as:***

- An open door policy in the school office and after school (although appointments may sometimes be necessary to meet with a teacher).
- New Parents' meetings and Meet the Teacher sessions
- Parent Teachers Consultation evenings twice yearly.
- An annual Open Evening and termly Open Mornings.
- Information evenings.
- Sharing and birthday assemblies each week; school services; celebrations, concerts and shows.

### ***Provide opportunities for parents to be involved with school life through:***

- Becoming involved in the PTA (FOSP) and their events.
- Helping in school.
- Sharing an interest or specialism in school.
- Taking an interest in and supporting their child's learning.
- Being consulted on their views about school.

**As a school we will endeavour to:**

- Provide an inclusive, safe, caring and challenging learning environment to enable our children to achieve the skills, values and attitudes needed to attain high standards and equip them for life.
- Value every child as an individual.
- Provide homework in accordance with the school's homework policy and provide information and ideas for supporting your child at home.
- Communicate our policies and practices clearly to you.
- Keep you informed about school events, the topics to be taught during the year and about your child's progress.
- Welcome you into school and make ourselves available, by arrangement, to see you.
- Respond to any concerns that you bring to us.
- Provide opportunities for you to share your views on school issues.

**As a pupil I will try hard to keep the school rules, which are:**

- Always do my best.
- Tell the truth.
- Be in the right place at the right time.
- Solve problems in a sensible way.
- Act and speak safely, sensibly and respectfully.
- Treat others and all property in a kind and caring way.

**As a parent I / we will endeavour to:**

- Inform school about issues which may affect my child's well-being and progress at school.
- Ensure that my child wears the correct school uniform and has the correct kit/ equipment in school.

- Talk about school and staff in a positive way with my child; this includes correspondence on social media.

- Support the school approach to online safety and not deliberately upload or add any text, image, sound or videos that could upset or offend any member of the school community or bring the school into disrepute.
- Bring concerns that I might have about my child directly to the class teacher or the Headteacher.
