<b>To guarantee participation of all children in inter- school competition.</b>	<b>Every child from Reception to Year 6 has been involved in at least 1 sporting event per year off site (inter school competition.) Travel has been paid for.</b>	
<b>To ensure achievement for all in swimming.</b>	<b>All year 6 in 2014 reached at least Level 4</b>	<b>Identify current Year 6's that may need top up sessions to reach L4.</b>
<b>To ensure participation of all children in the Outdoor Pursuits Curriculum.</b>	<b>Every child in Year 6 has subsidised trip to PGL enabling them all to access the Outdoor Pursuits Curriculum in 2014 and 2015.</b>	
<b>To make sure all children have access to high quality PE teaching.</b>	<b>Four staff and 2 parents have had CPD, building their confidence in specific areas or PE teaching. Release time for PE leader has enabled the organisation of a sports coach to do paired teaching and observations in 4 year groups, supporting teachers to improve PE teaching. Evidence in end of year assessments, district and county achievements and number of children from St Pauls selected for teams in Year 7 and 8. A full day organised to improve quality of Watford FC run after school clubs. This will hopefully lead to more children attending these clubs and higher quality teaching.</b>	<b>Evaluate impact of this through PE observations. Tag Rugby support in Year 4. Striking and fielding support in Year 3 and 5.</b>
<b>To provide resources and equipment, to ensure exciting and stimulating PE lessons and after school clubs.</b>	<b>Better equipment has meant more events happen at St Pauls- home games are now played at home! Regularly updated equipment to enable progression and differentiation in PE lessons.</b>	<b>Playground equipment needs updating.</b>
<b>To develop leadership of young people in PE and Sport across the school.</b>	<b>Sports Committee have equipment to lead lunchtime clubs- developed their confidence across other curriculum areas. They have run termly sports afternoons for KS1 and KS2.</b>
