School Run Club Information:

KS2 Choir

'The aim of our choir sessions is for children to come and enjoy singing songs with a range of styles. As well as developing their voices, children will have a chance to experience the fun and joy of singing. There will be opportunities for children to perform some of their songs at school church events.'

Homework Club

Children do not need to sign up for this club but do need to sign in when they attend. Generally we like to encourage children who have difficulty accessing the computer at home or children revising or completing work, to attend at least once a week. We will, however, limit the number of times a child attends.

Netball Club

Children will practise drills to help them learn the basics of netball. They will play games (both Hi-5 and 7 aside), learning tactics and improving skills. There is the opportunity to be selected for a 7 aside league team and Hi-5 mixed league team.

KS2 Recorder Club

Recorder club will be offered as a beginners and intermediate. Pupils will need a descant recorder and 'Recorder Magic Book 1'. If you wish to purchase either or both of these through school, please place payment in a clearly labelled envelope with your requirements and return to the office no later than Thursday 20th July. The cost of the recorder is £6.00 and the book is £4.00. Alternatively, you can purchase these yourself from elsewhere. *Please note: this club may have to be cancelled at short notice some weeks as Miss Moore has to attend many meetings, some offsite, so it is difficult to always make a regular commitment. Of course this club will run whenever possible.*

Cross Country Club

This fun club will take place at lunchtimes. Children will work to improve their fitness and stamina through running games and activities, and build up length of runs. Most sessions will take place on Chipperfield Common and in the Chipperfield woods. There will be an opportunity for some to take part in district and county events.

Drama and Story-telling Club

The club will be drama and story based. It will involve writing, retelling, acting, music, art and lots of imagination! This will be great for building confidence, creativity and communication.

Football Squad

Mark Swales has kindly offered to take on the training of the Yr 5-6 football team this year. After trials he will inform children of who has made it on the team. They will be entered into a league and will need to commit to attend training and games. Others who don't make the squad have the opportunity to join the Watford FC club and there may be chances for friendly matches.

It is important that we know all the clubs your child is attending, whether it is school run or run by another agency, as we need to make registers and split larger groups. Thanks.**
